## SRTC TEMPORARY COVID-19 CHANGES

SRTC will continue to admit any applicant by the assessment measures already in place whenever possible:

- a. SAT
- b. ACT
- c. PSAT
- d. Georgia Milestones Literature & Composition or Georgia Milestones American Literature & Composition (English admission requirement only
- e. HOPE GPA after completion of 10<sup>th</sup> grade of 2.6 or higher
- f. Accuplacer/Companion

If a student does not have any of these measures, we will use the following placement measures:

For degree (core) seeking 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> grade students:

• A cumulative GPA of a 2.6 from a high school transcript (unofficial is acceptable) will be admitted into a degree program

## For diploma or TCC seeking 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade students:

• A cumulative GPA of a 2.0 from a high school transcript (unofficial is acceptable) will be admitted into a diploma program or TCC

We are not offering the Accuplacer testing at this time. If a student does not meet the requirement above, he/she will be unable to participate at this time.

This exception is for Summer and Fall terms and these students will be allowed complete admission through their continuous enrollment.
